It involves professors and experts who ensure the curriculum meets regulatory requirements and industry needs, often by defining course structures, examination patterns, and teaching methodologies, s

Functions of a B.Ed Board of Studies

- Curriculum Design: Establishes the syllabi, course content, and learning objectives for B.Ed courses.
- Academic Standards: Sets and maintains the academic quality of the program, which includes determining the total marks for papers and their distribution.
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Ensures the curriculum aligns with national standards set by regulatory bodies like the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE).
- Course Structure: Defines the structure of the B.Ed program, including the number of semesters and the format of examinations, as seen in the example from R.C. College of Education.
- **Faculty Expertise:** Typically includes professors and subject matter experts to provide their knowledge and experience in shaping the academic program.
