Objectives of the SEDG Cell

- To provide academic, emotional, and financial support for their holistic development.
- To ensure equal participation and representation in all academic and co-curricular activities.
- To organize capacity-building programs such as mentoring, soft skills training, and remedial coaching.
- To liaise with welfare agencies/government bodies for scholarships and support schemes.

Functions of the Cell

- Maintain a confidential database of SEDG students.
- Disseminate information on scholarships, fee waivers, and support systems.
- Provide counseling and mentoring support.

- Coordinate with other cells (EOC, ICC, Career Guidance, etc.) to facilitate inclusive growth.
- Submit periodic reports to Principal regarding activities and impact.
